Staking out CAD objects without Points

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Thesis

This FAQ shows how to Stakeout (navigate to) locations which are not defined by points. Attributes like: Endpoints, Midpoints, Intersections, polyline Nodes, Centers, Tangents and Nearest points can be selected from lines, polylines, arcs and circles.

Method

Suppose we would like to Stakeout the midpoint of the specific line segment shown in CAD:







From the **STAKEOUT** tab, click on **Points**:



On the Select point dialog, click on Coordinates:

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On the Stakeout coordinates dialog, click on the Select icon:



Click on the Snap button to set object snaps:



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Enable the **Snap** modes that you need:



Note: Extreme = Endpoint and Medium = Midpoint. Click on CLOSE.

From the CAD selection screen, click near the midpoint of the line:



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A small selection box will be shown, then the coordinates of the midpoint will be shown:



Click Next and stake normally:
